THIS MORNING:

Everything starts out small and grows from there. Those who try to make a big splash and “go for broke” right at the start often do, in fact, end up broke. The lesson of the seed is universal. A small seed falls from a tree. Over the seasons it starts to take root in the ground. After a few years, branches appear, then more, and finally the small tree begins to bear its own fruit.

This is how it was with the ministry of Jesus Christ. No one even knew who he was for thirty years. Then, on the banks of the Jordan River, John the Baptist starting calling people to repent of their sins, and told them of one greater than he who was about to come. When Jesus appeared publicly he was alone. But one by one followers gathered around him. First John and Andrew; then Peter and Philip; then Nathanael and others until he had an entourage that followed him back and forth across the land of Israel. No one ever knows what the response will be when we invite people to follow Jesus. And no one ever knows what the followers of Jesus will be able to accomplish in the days of their discipleship. But our job and responsibility is to faithfully let people know about the Saviour, and invite them to follow him.
