SUNDAY, JUNE 7TH, 2015

THIS MORNING:

One of the first things a city dweller notices when getting out into the country at night is how different the sky looks. I remember moving from downtown Toronto to Otterburne, Manitoba, and being literally "star-struck." I would take walks alone at night, gaze at the night sky, and feel haunted by a sense of the vastness of the universe, the greatness and glory of God, and a sense of my own insignificance. King David had a similar experience as recorded in Psalm 8. He said, "When I consider your heavens, the work of your fingers, the moon and stars which you have set in place, what is man that you are mindful of him...?" (Psalm 8:4). This Psalm of David shows us how considering creation can stir our prayer life. It also teaches us about who God is as Creator, who we are as creatures, and what that means for our lives. This is what we will be considering this morning in our sermon entitled, "Talking to God When I Am Outdoors."
