

**WHAT'S BAPTISM ALL ABOUT?**

1. An illustration of union with Christ – Romans 6:3-4  
*<sup>3</sup> Or don't you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? <sup>4</sup> We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life.*

2. An expression of commitment to Christ - Acts 2:38-41  
*<sup>38</sup> Peter replied, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. <sup>39</sup> The promise is for you and your children and for all who are far off--for all whom the Lord our God will call." <sup>40</sup> With many other words he warned them; and he pleaded with them, "Save yourselves from this corrupt generation." <sup>41</sup> Those who accepted his message were baptized, and about three thousand were added to their number that day.*

3. An act of obedience to Christ - Matthew 28:19  
*<sup>19</sup> Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,*

**THIS MORNING:**

If all has gone as planned, we will have baptized three individuals earlier this morning at The Oasis. You may have seen the baptisms this morning, but you might wonder how to explain what it's all about. It's easy for things like baptism to appear as religious rituals or human traditions, and completely miss their deep significance. So this morning, we are going to answer the question, "What is Baptism?" by looking at three New Testament texts. We won't deal with all that the New Testament says about baptism, and we won't be able to answer every question. But we do hope to provide some clear teaching that helps us understand the meaning of baptism, not only to strengthen our own spiritual lives, but also to equip us to give a clear answer to someone who asks, "What's baptism all about?"
