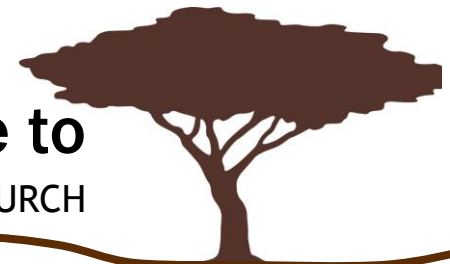
SUNDAY, JUNE 21ST, 2015

THIS MORNING:

God has always had certain men He has called upon down through the years to proclaim His word to the world.
