THIS MORNING:

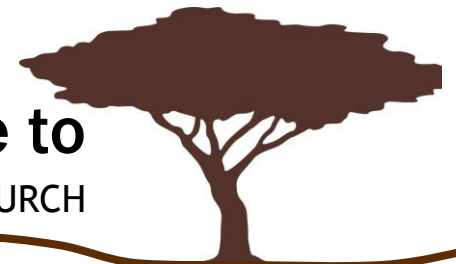
How can you pray when you are neck deep in a swamp of your own sin? That's what Psalm 51 is all about. King David was a great man, but he was also a great sinner. In a moment of weakness, he gave in to temptation, committed adultery with another man's wife, and then arranged to have that man killed. David got away with it, for a time, until God sent Nathan the prophet to confront him (2 Samuel 12). The Psalm we are looking at today is what followed that confrontation. It's David's humble prayer for forgiveness from God in light of the terrible things he had done.

Though we may not find ourselves in exactly David's situation, we know from the Scriptures, and from our own experience (if we are honest), that we are sinners in need of God's forgiveness. How should we talk to God, particularly during those times when we feel too guilty and ashamed to even approach him? That's what we will be looking at today, as we continue in our Series in the Psalms, "Talking to God."
