THIS MORNING:

Fear is an emotion we all experience. There are about as many “phobias” (the Greek word for fear) as there are things to be afraid of in this world. There are the better-known fears, such as *arachnophobia* (fear of spiders), and *claustrophobia* (fear of small spaces). But there are also some lesser-known fears, such as *pediophobia* (fear of dolls) and *podophobia* (fear of feet—apparently this is a genuine phobia!).


Whether or not we can personally identify with these, we all experience fear in one form or another. These fears (whether legitimate or illegitimate), often hold us back from living effectively as a follower of Christ, and at the very worst, they can crush us.

Although King David was a man of incredible courage, at times he felt fear like anyone else. This morning, we will look at Psalm 56, which is David’s prayer for help when he was in a terrifying situation. Though David’s fears were very real, they provided him with an opportunity to trust God. Using David’s example, this Psalm models for us how we can deal with our fears as we talk to God in prayer.
