THIS MORNING:

Modern technology has taken the challenges out of traveling. GPS systems have made something as simple as reading a map a lost art form. No need to determine north or south, or where to hang a right. In commercial airplanes, the pilots punch in the coordinates of their destination city before takeoff and that's what governs the flight path for 350 people for the next eight hours. When it comes to your life, though, there's no GPS. There's no device to tell you what job you should have, or how much to spend on a car, or which friends you should hang out with. Fortunately we have God's word to direct us when it comes to these things.
