SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 6TH, 2016

THIS MORNING:

Jesus did not come to earth to start a new religion! We read in the gospels that he taught people the way to God. Jesus told us that he himself is the way to the Father. Later, in the book of Acts, we read about the early disciples who followed the Way. Technically speaking, there is no Christian religion. Religions are all about rules and regulations. We do not receive salvation by attending worship a certain number of times, by praying a certain number of times a day, by doing certain deeds, eating certain foods and dressing in certain clothes. But while there is no Christian religion, there is a Christian Way. It is all about following Jesus and trusting in him as our Saviour.

The Christian Way is the way that Christ himself lived. We honour him when we do what he did, speak as he spoke, and live as he lived. When we do this, Jesus said that we are like salt and light in this world. It doesn't take much of one or the other to make its presence felt. Today we will try to understand a little more about this Christian Way, this way of living that demonstrates the presence of God in our lives and in this world.
