THIS MORNING:

Elections always seem to bring out the worst in people. We have just witnessed a stomach-churning race for the White House in the United States. All kinds of things were said and done in the lead-up to voting day. Even now, feelings have been hurt and wounds have been opened up that may take months to heal. Christians, also, got involved in the contest with evangelical leaders calling each other out and criticizing one another for the stands they took on certain issues. If that shows us anything, it is that within the church of Jesus Christ there are a variety of issues that people consider important and are willing to take different stands on.

Elections also bring to light the ambivalence that we as Christians experience when we try to apply our faith to this-world living. Spiritually we are connected to Jesus Christ, but materially we are very much a part of this world, with all of its needs, hurts and problems staring us in the face every day. It's part of the Christian adventure to live our faith in the context of world affairs. This morning we will investigate how our faith in Christ, and the guidance of God's Word gives us wisdom to navigate the course of life in this world around us.

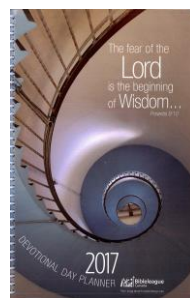
OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD

ANNUAL CHURCH BUSINESS MEETING & ELECTIONS

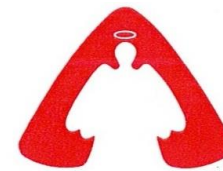
TONIGHT AT 6:00 PM
