## **FIRST ADVENT SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 27<sup>TH</sup>, 2016**

### **THIS MORNING:**

Hope is the most powerful motivator in the human experience. It energizes everything that we do. We work in hopes of getting a paycheque; we travel in hopes of arriving at our destination; we wage war in hopes of defeating an enemy and making peace; we enter into a courtship in hopes of getting married. Everything hinges on hope. Hope also energizes our Christian life as well. The Bible says that our blessed hope is the second coming to earth of our Lord Jesus Christ. At that time, all wars will cease, all poverty and want will be eradicated, all broken relationships will be restored and we will experience a glorious, eternal life on the new earth.

The reason we have hope for a second coming of Christ to this earth is because there was, many years ago, a first coming. It is the first coming of Jesus to earth that we remember during this season of Advent. From the days of Adam and Eve, God promised a Saviour who would come and free men and women from the tyranny and oppression of sin. All through the pages of Scripture, we read of Abraham and Moses and Joshua and David and Samuel and Isaiah and Malachi who spoke of a future day when the Saviour would come. And then – one day – he came. As a baby born in Bethlehem. Who lived and died to bring us salvation. He is the one we worship today.

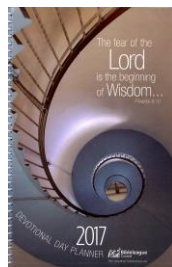
