THIS MORNING:

How much money will you spend this Christmas? I have often thought that I'm glad I'm not raising my kids in the year 2016. Back in 1985, we bought things like \$20 trucks and dolls for our kids. Today, something like a Sony PlayStation 4 will set you back \$400. Then you have to buy the controllers at \$75 each. And just to use it, you need the games at anywhere from \$40 to \$200 each. Parents could be out \$750 just to provide their kids with a game system that will keep them indoors when the sun is shining and distract them from doing their homework during the school year. Then there's tablets (\$400), drones (\$300), RC cars (\$250) and hoverboards (\$500). Even just a Power Rangers Morphin Megazord will cost you \$70.

And we haven't even talked about the food, the decorations, the musicals, and the ugly Christmas sweaters that will be purchased to celebrate the season. At what point do we say "enough" and start to dial things back? We may upset our kids who don't get their coveted super-toy, but we need to find some balance here. Especially when a child in Uganda would love to have just \$10 worth of food to get him through the month. Or \$39 would restore sight to a blind father with a family to support. I think it's about time we really, seriously consider the option of under-indulging our own desires, and consider the needs of others.
