THIS MORNING:

As we head into the second Sunday of a new year, some of us are intent on reforming our lives in some way or other. Others have already given up those resolutions we made only one week ago. Still others are hanging on, white-knuckled, determined to stick to those resolutions at least until February. And then there are those strange people (I’m not one of them) who are able to stay on that diet, stick to that exercise plan, and get rid of that old bad habit. How on earth do they do it? I have no idea. If I did, I’d be one of them!

Change is not easy, but with the right amount of planning and determination, it is possible—at least in some areas of life. On the other hand, the Bible is clear that there are some things about us that are impossible to change. Most significantly, we cannot make ourselves righteous enough to be accepted by a holy and righteous God, no matter how hard we try. It was this truth that tormented a 16th century German Monk named Martin Luther, until he came to understand God’s grace in the gospel while reading Paul’s letter to the Romans.

It was this understanding of the gospel that not only changed Luther, but also led to the Protestant Reformation whose 500th anniversary we celebrate this year. This morning, we will look at those same verses in Romans that had such a transforming effect in Luther’s life, and can do the same for us, if we will listen and respond to them in faith.
