THIS MORNING:

This weekend is our annual spring Missions Weekend. Over the years we have taken this occasion to hear from various missionaries that serve under our NAB conference. We have heard from missionaries who served in Mexico, Nigeria, Cameroon, Romania, Japan and Brazil. As "Nabbies", we can be proud of the work that our conference has done around the world. In Japan, the NAB has had missionaries since 1951. The first generation of missionaries have retired, and now the second generation is working in full swing.

Paul and Melissa Ewing are among those second generation missionaries. We have had Paul speak at our Mission Weekend in previous years, and it is good to have him back with us again this year. Japan has a population of 127 million people, of whom only two million call themselves Christians. If we are the light of the world, that means Japan is 98.5% dark, and only 1.5% light. Philippians 2:15 tells us that we are to shine like stars in a dark sky. Today, Paul will speak to us about what it means to shine as lights in the universe as we hold out the word of life to those who do not know it.
