SUNDAY, APRIL 30TH, 2017

THIS MORNING:

We all know that a Christian is a “Christ one”, someone who follows Jesus Christ. But a lot of times we might think that we are following when really we’re not. We get caught up with our lives – our jobs, our families, our finances, our houses, our cars, our boats, our vacations – and really don’t think about what all those things have to do with our relationship with Jesus. “WWJD” is a well-known acronym for “What Would Jesus Do?” It’s a good question: what WOULD he do in your situation? How do we know what he would do? How can we live in such a way that we can know that we are, in fact, being good followers of Jesus?

This morning we will start a short series about “Learning to Live Like Jesus”. It will address some of the issues in our lives that should mark us out as being followers of Jesus. Today we start with the question of knowing what God’s will for us is. Surely, if we are Christ-followers, we should be concerned about doing the will of God in our lives. Jesus certainly was. Other things to consider are the way he related to people, what he taught about material wealth and what counts as valid religious practice. As we look at these things, our desire is to learn to live like Jesus.

GOING ON A SHORT-TERM MISSION TRIP?

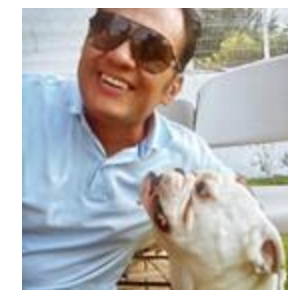
