JEFF AND SONYA KILMARTIN NAB MISSIONARIES, CAMEROON

For the past eight years, the Kilmartins have fostered a connection with the Fulbe people, a nomadic group in West Africa. They are now planning to return to West Africa to work at the seminary in Ndu, Cameroon, though they will also travel and minister among the Fulbe in Cameroon and Nigeria. Pray for the ongoing process of learning the Fulfulde language so they will more easily be able to communicate directly with the Fulbe people they interact with.
