THIS MORNING:

PRAY FOR MUSLIMS

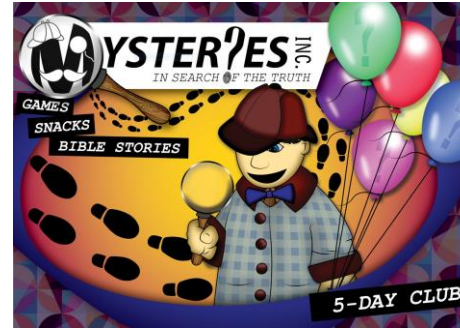
