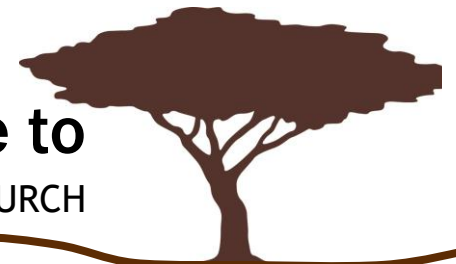
SUNDAY, JUNE 25TH, 2017
