SUNDAY, JULY 23RD, 2017

THIS MONTH:

In a time of transition, change is inevitable. This is also true in the life of a local church. The prospect of change tends to excite some people and make others nervous. We wonder, "What exactly will change, when will it change, and what will that mean for me?" Thankfully, we can be confident that God never changes (James 1:17); his character, plans, and promises always remain the same. Furthermore, there are some things that the Bible instructs us to do and to keep on doing until the Lord Jesus comes back or calls us home. During the month of July, we will consider some of these never-changing marks of a faithful church, as we aim to stay on track in a time of transition.
