THIS MORNING:

Today, as we continue in the book of 1 Samuel, we find the nation of Israel asking for a king to lead them. As much as the prophet Samuel warns them of the consequences of having such a king, they refuse to listen and adamantly demand that he give them one, so that they will “be like the other nations, with a king to lead us and to go out before us and fight our battles” (1 Sam 8:20).

In the same way, we often ask God for things that we would not ask for if we were wiser. Yet sometimes, God in his wisdom grants our requests—not because he intends to ruin us, but because he wants to reveal to us things about ourselves, and also show us how much we need him. That’s the focus of today’s sermon, as we continue our series, “Samuel: Steadfast and True in Stormy Times.”
