THIS MORNING:

In case you hadn't noticed, there's an election campaign going on in Canada. That explains why you've been seeing so much of Stephen, Tom and Justin on your TV sets lately. They all have something important to say to Canadians. And they all are telling us that the other guys are wrong and they're right. It can be very confusing to say the least. No one party offers exactly what you would like to see. In a way, what we are confronted with is kind of like ordering your selection of cable packages. One of them has good sports and drama coverage, but if you want financial news, you have to go with a different package. But then you don't get the sports you want... How do we decide?

It would be nice if the Bible told us how to vote. Some people have tried to infer – in contorted kinds of ways – that it does just that. But it doesn't. The whole area of how Christians deal with politics is fraught with many a pitfall and difficulty. Many Christian leaders have discredited themselves by endorsing politicians who later turned out to be downright crooks. That's why some Christians have said not to get involved in politics at all. But then that removes the voice and views of Christians from a tremendously vital area of society. Today we will look at some Biblical principles that will help us sort through some of these issues. It still won't tell you how to vote – but hopefully it will help in your final decision.
