### **THIS MORNING:**

Today we are continuing our sermon series in the book of James. James has a lot to say about how our Christian faith ought to find practical expression in our daily lives. In other words, he's concerned with "how the rubber meets the road." Apparently, during the time when James wrote his letter, there were people who thought that being a Christian had much to do with believing and saying the right things and very little to do with doing the right things. This mindset is common in our context today, and it not only harms our churches, but it also hinders our witness to the world.

This issue is something all Christians should be concerned about, and we must begin by looking honestly at ourselves. Is the faith I claim to have the real deal, or is it a sham? James will help us answer that question as we examine what he has to say about the danger of a "dead" faith.
