SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 15TH, 2015

THIS MORNING:

“Sticks and stones may break my bones, but words will never hurt me.” I can't remember the first time I heard this saying, but I do remember, even as a kid, realizing that it was completely false. We know from experience that words can hurt a great deal. Wounds on the skin left by physical blows tend to heal much faster than the wounds on the soul that are left by verbal blows. We know this because we have been on the receiving end of such blows. We also know this because we have dealt these blows to others. As the book of Proverbs says, “Death and life are in the power of the tongue” (Proverbs 18:21).

Today we are continuing our series in the New Testament Letter of James. Near the beginning of his letter, James writes, “If anyone considers himself religious and yet does not keep a tight rein on his tongue, he deceives himself and his religion is worthless” (James 1:26). Those are some strong words about words! This morning, we will see how James develops this theme and what it means for our own lives, as we consider what he has to say about how True Religion Tames the Tongue (James 3:1-12).
