Walls of Freedom is an organization that seeks to minister the love of Christ in Winnipeg's core area. They are seeking donations of the following items:

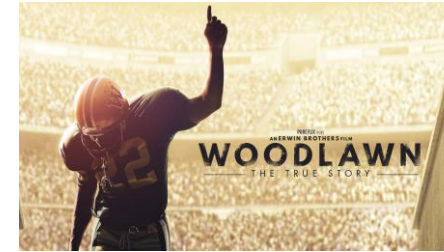

After becoming a Christian in 2005, Nicolas studied at Word of Life Bible Institute in Buenos Aires. Then in 2009, he and his brother formed Ministerio Edificando Sobre el Fundamento (Building on the Foundation Ministry), a church-planting ministry, with the goal of planting churches across the province of Salta in Argentina.
