SUNDAY, JANUARY 31ST, 2016

THIS MORNING:

The most difficult aspect of human endeavour is that of interpersonal relationships. Compared to this, everything else in life is simple. Consider - if your car needs a new fuel pump, you take out the old one and put in a new one, and your car works again. Simple! If you have a problem with debt, you stop spending more than you earn and in a few years you will be debt-free. Simple! Even in the area of complex mathematical problem solving, a computer can calculate factors such as gravitational pull, thrust, payload and fuel consumption so that we can send men to the moon. Why is this? Because fuel pumps, money and rocket ships can't talk back. They don't have a mind of their own. They do what we tell them to do. Such is not the case with human relationships. That's why companies from small firms right up to multi-national corporations spend so much money each year on their departments of human resources.

We read in the Bible that Jesus grew "in favour with men". That means people thought well of him. We are told that large crowds followed him and that he positively impacted thousands of people and that "the common people heard him gladly". If we want to learn how to deal properly with other people, we can find no better example than that of Jesus. The only people that didn't like him were the proud, and powerful religious establishment, and the reason is because Jesus exposed them for who they were - arrogant power brokers who were not willing to give up their status. Today, as we conclude our series on growing like Jesus, we will look at some factors that will help us to "grow in favour with men", just like Jesus.
