SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 21ST, 2016

THIS MORNING:

When Jesus was standing trial before Pontius Pilate, Pilate asked him if he was a king. It came out in the conversation that Jesus was, in fact, a king. But he was not the kind of king that Pilate was thinking of. And he was not the type of king that this world is looking for. Jesus said “My kingdom is not of this world.” In making that statement, Jesus was expressing his disdain for any kind of political influence or power that kings on this earth try to attain. It’s as if there are children playing in a sandbox with plastic trucks and bulldozers, making roads in the sand for their Matchbox cars to drive on. Meanwhile, a few miles away, there is a real-life contractor with real trucks and bulldozers, moving tons of dirt and rock to build a new highway for people to drive real cars and trucks on. Imagine how ludicrous it would be for a grown man to spend all his time and effort with the children in the sandbox, fighting over who gets to play with the plastic trucks, while the real trucks and bulldozers are being ignored.

When Jesus said “My kingdom is not of this world”, it was because the kingdom he was establishing was a real kingdom that is as different from this world as a real highway development project is from a sandbox. Over the next few weeks we will look at incidents in the life of Christ taken from the gospel of John that show us how Jesus’ kingdom is far different and better than anything we could hope to see in this world, starting this morning with John chapter two.
