EASTER SUNDAY MARCH 27TH, 2016

THIS MORNING:

Today is the day Christians celebrate the greatest event of all time. It’s the day that saw God do something that had never been done in the history of the entire world. It was the day that a man who had been dead for three days was brought back to life. And not just as a resuscitated human body, but as a glorious new creation that was unlike any human body in all of history. The resurrection of Jesus Christ is the event that marks the intellectual divide between believers and non-believers, between Christians and non-Christians. The Bible says that those who believe in their hearts that Christ was raised from the dead can be saved. You can’t be a Christian, a follower of Jesus, a born-again child of the kingdom of God, without understanding and believing that Jesus Christ was raised from the dead on Easter Sunday two thousand years ago.

If someone asks you if you believe in the resurrection of Jesus Christ, it calls for a definite, confident, affirmative response. It’s not the type of question you can mumble an answer to. That’s why Christians in Europe developed a tradition of joining together every Easter morning with the joyful expression: “Christ is risen!” and the response: “He is risen indeed!” Today we celebrate joyfully and confidently by faith that Christ is risen! Hallelujah!
