In the midst of all this, we as a church also have a message to get out into the world. We call this outreach. It's a challenge, to be sure. Sometimes we feel like our message gets lost in the din. People are either too busy to listen, or hostile to any mention of God, or just plain apathetic. Yet Jesus tells us that as his followers, we are to go and tell others about the message of his saving grace and the difference it can make in their lives. That's why, in spite of the challenges, we as a church do outreach.
