**THIS MORNING:**

We are subjected to a lot of noise today in the form of tidal waves of information that come at us from hundreds of sources. One of the areas in which this happens is around the topic of motherhood. Women have been mothers ever since Eve bore Cain and Abel. It’s a pretty basic concept, really. You have a child – you become a mother. It’s true the issues confronting mothers change from generation to generation, but the basics remain the same. That’s why God gave us some basic principles about mothers which can be summed up in a couple of sentences: husbands, love and cherish the mothers of your children; children obey and respect your mothers. The reason is because, along with fathers, mothers are the most important people in the world. They are the ones who teach the next generation. They are the ones who provide for the needs of the next generation. They are the ones who set the morals and standards that the next generation will live by. The hand that rocks the cradle rules the world. Mothers are world-changers – one life at a time. That’s why they are so important.

Today we want to look at three women who changed the world they lived in by being faithful and true to those around them. They were insignificant women in the eyes of the world they lived in. We don’t even know the name of one of them. But by their quiet strength and courageous will, they had significant impact on their society and in the work that God was doing in the world.
