SUNDAY, MAY 15TH, 2016

THIS MORNING:

One of the most amazing stories in all of history is the continuing saga of the nation of Israel. We have the story of Israel spelled out for us in the Bible, starting with God's call to Abraham and his promise to bless him above all nations. It's fascinating to read how the children of Abraham multiplied in number, then were enslaved in Egypt, then were released from bondage and led to their land of promise, then to see how they worked together to form the nation of Israel under their different kings. Because of disobedience to God's laws, they suffered at the hands of other nations, and were ultimately destroyed and scattered to the four winds by the Roman armies in 70 AD.

But God had plans for Israel, and even before these events, he spoke through the prophets about a day when the Jews would be brought back to their own land and would live in peace and security. In our own day we have seen the fulfillment of these prophecies as we have seen Jews from all over the world emigrate to Israel and work to establish the nation that we see today. The Bible tells us that Israel was to be a light to the nations, and a means of blessing all people with salvation. This morning we want to see what the Bible has to say about these things and what it means for us.
