SUNDAY, MAY 29TH, 2016

THIS MORNING:

I remember being on a church canoe trip one summer as a kid. I was at the stern, and my buddy was at the bow, and our canoe was loaded down with supplies. A strong wind swept the lake and we were suddenly paddling against the waves and doing our best to keep from capsizing. There was a lot of struggling and yelling in that canoe before we finally arrived onshore. It reminds me of a passage in the Gospel of Mark (Mark 6:45-52). The disciples are trying to cross the Sea of Galilee in a boat, struggling against the wind and waves, while Jesus has gone off to pray by himself on land. I can imagine that there was some yelling in that boat as the beleaguered disciples paddled against the waves into the wee hours of the night.

As followers of Jesus, we are sometimes led to believe that the Christian life will be smooth sailing as long as we are “in the will of God” and doing what he has commanded us. But the experience of the disciples here teaches us otherwise. They were doing exactly as Jesus had commanded; nevertheless, they found themselves caught in the middle of a dark and difficult struggle. And yet it was in this darkness and difficulty that Jesus chose to reveal himself to his disciples in an unforgettable way. This morning, as we read about how the disciples saw Jesus in the wind and waves that night, we will consider what it means for us as we seek to follow him today.
