SUNDAY, JUNE 5TH, 2016

THIS MORNING:

Over the past month here in Canada, we have witnessed the devastation of a forest fire that destroyed parts of the city of Fort McMurray. Many people lost everything as the fire completely consumed their houses and all that they contained. I can't imagine what it would be like to see all that you have worked for and saved and built over decades taken away from you in a matter of minutes. The image of losing one's house is a familiar one in the gospels. Jesus told a parable about two men who each built a house. One did it the right way; the other did it the wrong way. When the inevitable storms came, one of them stood and the other was destroyed.

In the case of Fort McMurray, people have insurance, and while their loss is great, they will be able to build a new house for themselves. In the parable that Jesus told, the houses being built refer to your life. We are each building a life. It's been said "there's a right way and a wrong way to do everything." While you can re-build a physical house, if you build your life the wrong way, there's no do-over. In the Bible we read Jesus' words telling us the right way to build your life. Today we begin a series of sermons on the parables of Jesus and we will look at the parable of the two builders. We each want to build a good life and Jesus tells us how to do that. If we follow his words, we will stand firm when the storms come and we can be assured of his blessings in this life and the life to come.
