SUNDAY, JUNE 12TH, 2016

THIS MORNING:

There are instances in life where we can see that something small can have a great effect. A little bit of fertilizer scattered over the grass will cause our lawn to grow rich and green. A little bit of spicy peppers on the pizza will cause our mouth to burn. Some things like these have an impact far beyond their size or volume. The same is true of followers of Jesus in this world. Sometimes we wonder if we have any effect at all when we see what is happening around us. But Jesus told a number of parables to his disciples that indicate that our influence in the world is far greater than we might think or imagine.

In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus referred to us as "salt" and "light". These are two entities that, even though used in small amounts, have an effect far greater than seems obvious at first. If it were not for salt, our food would taste a lot less desirable, and if were not for light at night, we would all stumble and fall. Salt and light are indispensable to this world, and what Jesus is saying is that his followers are likewise indispensable in ways that we may not even realize. Today we will hear about ways that we can use our saltiness and spread our light so others can benefit by it.

Brochures for Summer Camp are available on the table in the lobby. Registrations are open online at www.campnutimik.com.

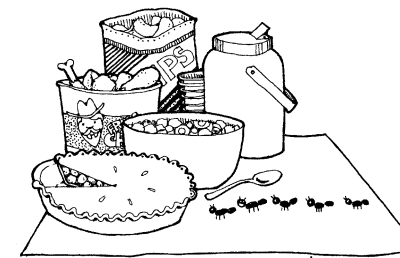
