THIS MORNING:

You've heard it said "Any man can be a father, but it takes a special man to be a dad." I think we all understand the sentiment of this statement inasmuch as becoming a father can be reduced to a purely biological event, but to earn the title "Dad" takes time, effort and commitment. In the Bible, Jesus refers to God as our heavenly Father. He presents him as the one who has given us life, who sustains us by providing for our needs, and who desires a personal relationship with us whereby we come to him with our joys, fears, burdens and needs. When you experience God in this way, you know him as not only your heavenly Father, but your heavenly Dad.

This may sound irreverent to some, but the apostle Paul encourages us to think of God this way when he says that when we come to him in prayer we can call him "Abba". This is the Hebrew word for "daddy". When I was in Israel, I heard many children call out their father using this word. In the parable we are looking at today – the Prodigal Son – we see Jesus portraying God as a caring father who provides, loves, forgives and restores us in relationship to him. As such, we gain insight into the effort and commitment it takes for us men to be a real father – the kind of dad our children need and deeply desire.
