THIS MORNING:

Nobody invests in anything without the expectation of a good return. Not only that, but an investor wants to know the terms and conditions of the investment and these are always spelled out in a legal document that everyone signs and agrees to before any money changes hands. If, after handing over his money, the investor discovers that the guardians of his investment are not keeping up their end of the bargain, the investor will withdraw from the investment and may even pursue legal action to punish the guardians for their malpractice. Then he will pursue some other individuals with which to invest. This is essentially the storyline of the parable of the tenants that Jesus told.

Basically, God made an investment in Israel 'way back in the Old Testament times. The leaders of Israel, however, broke the terms of the investment and tried to take a controlling position for themselves. They not only did not pay what they owed, they tried to steal the asset from God. So God decided to take back his investment and pursue a different partner. The investment in the parable was a vineyard. The investment God makes in real life is in the lives of people. In all of this there is both warning and promise for us as we partner with God in what he is doing in our world.
