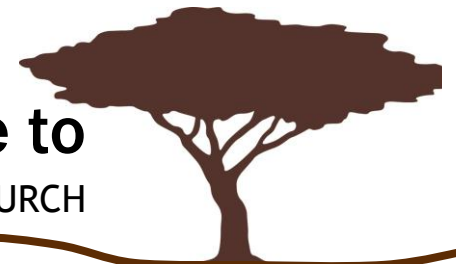
**THIS MORNING:**

One of the most difficult obstacles many people have in trusting Jesus as their saviour from sin is how they view Him. Some people see Jesus as a moral man, others see Him as a nice bearded guy, and some as a great teacher who now has many followers. In his book *Mere Christianity*, C.S. Lewis makes it clear that these views of Jesus cannot be true. This is what he says:

“I am trying here to prevent anyone saying the really foolish thing that people often say about [Jesus]: I’m ready to accept Jesus as a great moral teacher, but I don’t accept his claim to be God. That is the one thing we must not say. A man who was merely a man and said the sort of things Jesus said would not be a great moral teacher. He would either be a lunatic — on the level with the man who says he is a poached egg — or else he would be the Devil of Hell. You must make your choice. Either this man was, and is, the Son of God, or else a madman or something worse.”

These thoughts did not originate in the mind of C.S. Lewis, but from God’s Word. Today we will dive into Luke 7:36-50 and see Jesus Himself display that He is more than just a great teacher or prophet, but God, who is able to forgive the sins of all of mankind, and how that affects our own lives.

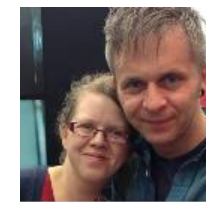
Come out to the P's for some board games, food and to hang-out around the fire pit. Starts at 6 pm.
