SUNDAY, JULY 31ST, 2016

THIS MORNING:

One of the sayings of Jesus that has made its way into our modern parlance is "the first shall be last". We often hear this used when someone or something (such as a sports team) who once held a high position has suddenly fallen from that position and is now seen a has-been. Sometimes this first-to-last scenario is expressed through the concept of "karma". Karma is a concept from eastern religions which states that good deeds and positive attitudes in life will result in future blessing and prosperity, while evil deeds and negativity leads to future pain and suffering. The problem with karma is that it is grounded in a fatalistic view of the universe. The Bible teaches us that a person – God – is in control of this universe and he will reward or punish men according to their deeds.

Actually the full statement of Jesus is "So the last will be first, and the first will be last." This statement contains both a warning for the mighty and a promise for the weak. He is saying that no one should feel either secure or hopeless about their lot in life because there is a day of reckoning coming when things will be made right. There is no story in the Bible that illustrates this point as well as the parable Jesus told that is found in Luke 16. It's the story of a rich man who lost everything, and a poor man who gained eternal life. Today we will look at this parable and find out some profound and probing truths that it has for us to learn.
