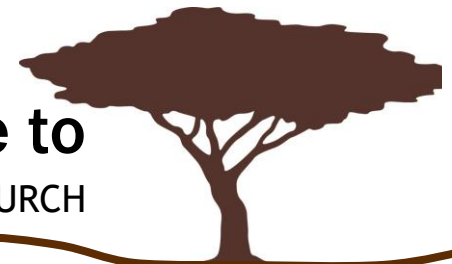
SUNDAY, AUGUST 7TH, 2016

THIS MORNING:

There are people who come into your life for only a short time yet leave a deep impression. I think of one old man in the church I attended in Vancouver during my teen years. His name was Mr. Lee. He fought for Canada in World War I. I often sat in the row in front of him and his wife. Once he told me a story of an encounter he had with another soldier who lay dying on the battlefield and how he gave the dying man some water from his canteen. It was a valuable gift of a precious resource that Mr. Lee did not have a lot of. It taught me much about what sacrifice and commitment really looked like. I can't remember anything else that Mr. Lee said to me in all those years. But I remember that.

In the Bible we have the story of Elijah. There are only five major anecdotes of Elijah's life that we have recorded for us in Scripture. They take up about eight pages, that's all. Yet the impact of Elijah was profound and he is portrayed throughout Scripture as a man who stood in the power of God to face down evil in a very dark and corrupt time in Israel's history. Over the next five Sundays we will look at the life of Elijah – a man chosen by God to stand for him and hold up a banner of righteousness before a sinful nation.

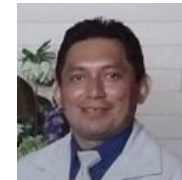
