THIS MORNING:

Some of the most amazing stories that come to light after a war or a major international conflict are the stories about men and women who infiltrated behind enemy lines to become double agents for one side or the other. Some of these individuals even found a place among the leadership of the opposing side. We call these people "moles". They were able to work their way, undetected, into the inner chambers of the enemy side. From there, they were able to do things that helped the cause of the side which they represented.

In our world today, there are secular powers in place that seem to be the very embodiment of evil. They are the enemies of light. For example, there is the atheistic tyranny of North Korea, which will put people in prison camps for just reading a Bible. There is the dictatorship of Bashar al-Assad in Syria, who thinks nothing of wiping out whole neighbourhoods of civilians to further his cause against the rebel forces against him. Yet the Bible seems to indicate, and history has often shown, that even in these dark places there are people who belong to God and are serving him in whatever way they can. They are God's moles, as it were. We sometimes find light in surprisingly dark places. That's what we learn from the story of Elijah that we will look at today. No matter where you are, and no matter how dark things look, God still calls you to live out your life of faith and shine your light.
