SUNDAY, JANUARY 29TH, 2017

THIS MORNING:

In the adventure movie “Indiana Jones and the Last Crusade”, Indiana Jones (Harrison Ford) is on a quest to find the Holy Grail which will save his father’s life. At one point, he passes through a deep crevice in a rock formation only to end up at a chasm with a thousand-foot drop and no way across. No bridge. No rope. No path. His father’s instructions tell him to step out in faith in order to make it to the other side. After some hesitation, he does what his father told him, steps out into thin air, and miraculously finds he is on solid footing. He is able to cross a bridge that he was not able to see and make it to safety on the other side.

The Bible tells us faith is “the evidence of things not seen”. In other words, even though we do not see something, we put our faith in it and we find that it works. We do not see Christ, yet we put our faith in him, and, lo and behold, we find that we receive what he has promised.
