Don't you wish everything in life came with an "easy" button? Truth is, most worthwhile things – whether marriage, parenting, vocation, or serving Christ – are often difficult. Timothy felt this as he struggled to be a faithful minister of the gospel under pressure. It's for this reason that the Apostle Paul, having completed his own ministry and awaiting execution in a Roman prison, wrote to Timothy, telling him to endure hardship and fulfill his calling. This ancient letter has a timeless message—not just for church leaders, but for everyone who has begun with Christ and wants to finish well. Join us in the coming weeks as we study Paul's second letter to Timothy, and consider how we can endure difficulty and remain faithful to the gospel we have been entrusted with.

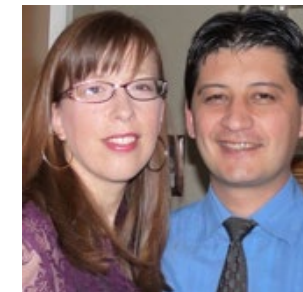

Lyndell Campbell-Réquia, NAB Missionary, Brazil
