Don't you wish everything in life came with an "easy" button? Truth is, most worthwhile things – whether marriage, parenting, vocation, or serving Christ – are often difficult. Timothy felt this as he struggled to be a faithful minister of the gospel under pressure. It's for this reason that the Apostle Paul, having completed his own ministry and awaiting execution in a Roman prison, wrote to Timothy, telling him to endure hardship and fulfill his calling. This ancient letter has a timeless message—not just for church leaders, but for everyone who has begun with Christ and wants to finish well.
