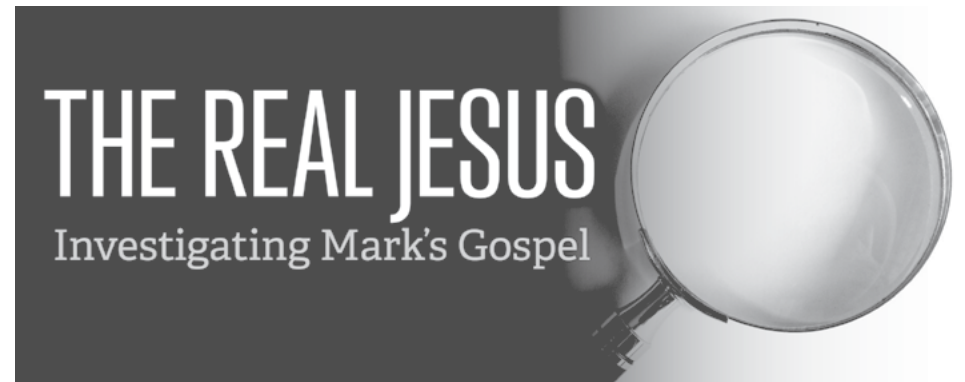


Who is Jesus?
