Cameroon

Rick and Debbie serve at Mbingo Baptist Hospital in Bamenda, Cameroon. Rick is a board-certified medical doctor in Internal Medicine and Pathology, and Debbie is a staff nurse. The last couple of months have been busy for them. Debbie spent a month in North America, most of the time with family; due to lack of pathology coverage, Rick was only able to get away for two weeks. Part of their time away was spent at Triennial, which was a great time of reunion and renewal. Continue to pray for the ongoing unrest in Cameroon, specifically that Mbingo Baptist Hospital would continue to be a neutral zone amidst the unrest.
