

Lyndell recently hosted and interpreted
for Randy Schmor from NAB Gateway as
he trained seminary students and pastors
about Sister-church Partnerships. They
travelled to the border city of Uruguaiana to
visit First Baptist Church, Sister church to
Pittsford Community Church in NY State.
She is currently preparing the apartment
for this month's arrival of the Jones family,
new missionaries to Brazil.

Paulo has been working with 2 church
planters in poor communities to send 20
children to summer camp in Jan/Feb '19.
