NAB MISSIONARIES

COMMUNITY HEALTH EVANGELISM  
(CHE) HUNGARY & SERBIA

We arrived back in Hungary on March 1st, dropped our bags, and flew to Tirana, Albania on March 3rd where we, along with the director of CHE Albania, taught a week-long course at the International School of Theology and Leadership on wholistic community development and developing sustainable partnerships.

After returning to Hungary, we drove to the Global Nomads training center near Burgas, Bulgaria, picking up Marijana Čizmanski along the way, to lead a Vision Seminar on how CHE could help them plant churches in Bulgaria and along the Silk Road to China. An unexpected blessing for our CHE Team was to learning about the Global Nomads Disciple Making Movement strategies. We are researching how to integrate them into our own community work.

We are currently in Macedonia, training the new CHE Team starting community outreach and development in two villages here. Following this we will be visiting & working with existing village teams in Hungary and Serbia before flying back to Kansas City on April 26th to participate in the annual CHE Representative Council Meetings and to attend and teach at the International Wholistic Missions Conference.

Thank you for upholding us in prayer as we travel and minister at home and abroad.
