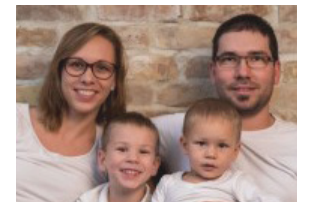
NAB MISSIONARIES
